GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR TENDER/BID

1. a. Scope of work : 1 Nos. of Ambulance Service on Contract Basis to ESIC Hospital, Adityapur for a period of 03 Months.
- b. Ambulance Type : Type C with Basic Life Support
- c. Ambulance Model : MPV
- d. Ambulance Variant : Force Traveller or equivalent model(s)
- e. Usage variant per month : 1500 Kilometer
- f. Year of Model : Not earlier than 2022

## 2. Eligibility Criteria:

- a. The bidder shall be Public Ltd. Company/Private Ltd. Company Firm/Society/Individual Owner/NGO.
- b. The bidder shall have valid license to run the ambulance Service.
- c. The bidder shall have valid registration under ESI Act/EPF Act. & Valid license from Govt. Authority.
- d. The bidders shall have Service Tax/GST Registration no.
- e. The bidders shall have PAN No.
- f. The bidders shall have a Bank Account in a Schedule Bank.
- g. The bidder shall not be a black listed by Govt./Semi-Govt./Private institution. Self certification in this regard shall be enclosed.
- h. The bidder shall be free from encumbrance and there shall not be any vigilance case/CBI Case/ Court Case pending against him.
- i. The bidders shall be in position to provide a vehicle with proper permit, certificate of pollution under control, proper Registration duly compliant with Motor Vehicles Act on immediate basis w.e.f. 01.06.2026.

## Note:

1. The Bidder shall have registration under various Act/Concerned Dept. As detailed above on date of submission of tender document merely submission of acknowledgement of application for registration will be deemed at par with non-registration under said Act /Concerned Dept.
2. The candidature of tenderer not fulfilling all or any of the above eligibility criteria is liable to be rejected.
3. Instructions to Tender: The Tenderer are required to submit the tender on Tender Box kept at the Hospital Premises or through email as per detailed guidelines provided hereinafter.

## 4. Opening of Bids:-

The bids shall be opened on 30.05.2026 at 11:00 AM in the Hospital Premises. Interested bidders may remain present during opening of the tenders.

## 5. Acceptance of Bid:



The successful bidder shall give its acceptance and shall deposit Performance Security @ 3 % of Total work value (in favour of ESI Fund A/c No. 1, payable at SBI Adityapur Bazar Branch (Cheque/Cash will not be accepted) for this purpose )within 7 days from the award of work order and required to enter into an agreement with Medical Superintendent, ESIC Hospital, Adityapur on bond paper of Rs.100/ (Rupees One hundred only). The cost of bond paper will be borne by successful bidder. In case, if successful bidder fails to give acceptance or deposit performance security deposit or enter into agreement within stipulated time, the award of contract will be deemed to be cancelled and EMD amount will be forfeited.. **On due performance and successful completion of the contract in all respect, the Performance Security money deposit shall be returned to the contractor without any interest**

The successful bidder shall immediately deploy the Ambulance w.e.f. 01.06.2026.

The work shall be normally awarded to the L-1 Bidder who is ready to supply the Ambulance w.e.f. 01.06.2026.

In case of failure to provide the Ambulance w.e.f. 01.06.2026, the Bid may be awarded to L-2 bidder and upon their failure to L-3 bidder and so on.

#### 5. Signing of Tender:

The tender is liable to be rejected if complete information is not given therein or if the particulars and date (if any) asked for in the tender are not duly & fully filled in. Particular attention may be given to the dates of delivery, places of delivery and also to the particulars referred to in the conditions of contract so as to comply with them.

In the case of companies and firms registered under the Indian Partnership Act, the capacity in which signing e.g. Secretary, Manager, and Partner etc. or their attorney and produce copy of documents, empowering him to do so, of called upon to do so.

**Note:** In case of unregistered firms, all the members or all Attorneys duly authorized by all of them or the Manager of the firm should sign the tender and subsequent documents.

#### 6. THIS TENDER IS NON-TRANSFERRABLE.

#### 7. SECURITY DEPOSIT/PERFORMANCE SECURITY:

Whenever any claim for the payment of a sum of money arises out of or under this contract against the tenderer the ESIC Hospital shall be entitled to recover of such sum by appropriating, in part or whole the security/earnest money deposited by the tenderer, when the balance or the total sum to be recoverable, as the case may be shall be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to recoverable under this or any other tenderer with the ESIC Hospital. If this sum should not be sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable, the tenderer shall pay to the ESIC Hospital on demand the remaining balance due.

Also, If the contractor fails in fulfilling the terms and conditions mentioned here in different parts of this tender document, such failure will constitute a breach of the contract and the Medical Superintendent reserves the right

to make other arrangements at the risk and expense of the contractor, also non-performance/unsatisfactory performance or violation of terms and condition of the contract will make the contractor liable for forfeiture of Security deposit. The decision of the Medical Superintendent shall be final and binding on this count.

**8. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITION:**

In case, if successful bidder fails to give acceptance or deposit performance security deposit or enter into agreement within stipulated time, the award of contract will be deemed to be cancelled and EMD/PSD amount will be forfeited. The successful/bidder who chose to enter into agreement after fulfilling the criteria are required to abide by following conditions.

1. The Drivers deployed by the Tenderer for running the ambulance shall be properly trained, have requisite experience/license and skills for carrying out the work assigned to him. Tenderer shall have the telephone number of the nearest police station, fire station and ambulance, Estate officer of ESIC etc., The names of deployed Drivers with driving license, ESI No., EPF No. should always be displayed on their uniform for identification purpose.
2. The Drivers so deployed shall have not any claim for permanent absorption in the hospital and if such claimed raised shall be violation of the terms and conditions of the agreement of the hospital authority shall have the right to cancel the agreement to terminate such deployment termination.
3. The tenderer will be responsible for such conduct of the persons engaged by him in the hospital, which will be conducive for maintaining as harmonious atmosphere as expected in the hospital and will be responsible for any act & omission of such persons. In event of any violation of laws, rules, statutory provisions by the tenderer, this will amount to breach of contract and in such case, the hospital will have the right for terminating the contract forthwith, without giving any notice or assigning any reason.
4. The Tenderer shall submit periodical return of ESI & EPF in r/o Drivers deployed at ESIC Hospital for running ambulance.
5. The Tenderer shall provide a list of Drivers to be deployed to run the ambulance well in advance with all the details like name, father's name, present address, qualification, driving license, mobile no., ESI No, EPF No and fitness certificate as per requirement of this tender.
6. The Tenderer at all times should indemnify ESIC against all claims, damages or compensation under the provisions of Code on wages, 2019; Industrial Relations Code, 2020; Occupational safety and health code, 2020 ; Social Security Code, 2020; Jharkhand Shops and Essential Act; Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 or any modification thereof or any other law relating thereto and rules made hereunder from time to time. ESIC will not own any responsibility in this regard.
7. In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to the contract, the Performance Security Deposit of the Contractor will be liable to be forfeited by ESIC besides annulment of the contract.
8. **The Contract shall be for a period of two (02) Months and may be extended further if required subject to satisfactory performance, on the same terms and conditions. The rates quoted by the bidder shall remain unchanged during the period of contract. ESIC, however, reserves the right to terminate the**



satisfactory

contract by serving one month notice, in writing. The Contract may be terminated with mutual consent by giving one-month notice in variations.

9. **Payment Procedure:**

The Tenderer shall prepare bills on calendar month basis (1<sup>st</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> /31<sup>st</sup>) and shall be submitted (in triplicate) up to 10<sup>th</sup> of following month along with details of payment of statutory liabilities like ESI, EPF, Services tax etc. of preceding month with all the relevant certificates/documents. If the bill is not submitted within the stipulated period, a penalty of Rs,2000/- shall be levied and the same will be deducted from the contractor's bills. The agency must make the payment to their workers through Bank transaction on or before 7<sup>th</sup> of each month & should be submitted with the monthly bill and this payment shall not be linked to the clearing of the bill by ESIC office. In event it is found that there is intentional under payment to deployed Drivers, the action including forfeiture of security deposit and cancellation of contract may be taken. All the payment (including that of Advance) to the drivers to be made by the agency through Bank transactions only. Cash payment is strictly prohibited. If the agency does not make payment to its drivers through bank the contract is liable to be terminated.

**The Payment shall be made as per the financial quotes submitted by the service Provider and as it, accepted by the ESIC. No advance payment shall be made to the Service Provider.**

**The bill shall be submitted with the following documents/details:**

- a. The wages of drivers for last month credited to their Bank Account on \_\_\_\_\_ and the details of payment along with Bank Account No. No cash payment is permissible & such payments are to be treated at par with non-payment of wages. There must be no deviation whatsoever in this regard.
- b. ESI Contribution for the month of \_\_\_\_\_ amounting to Rs \_\_\_\_\_ has been paid on \_\_\_\_\_
- c. EPF Contribution for the month of \_\_\_\_\_ amounting to Rs \_\_\_\_\_ has been paid on \_\_\_\_\_

- f. Wages of Drivers were credited to their Bank account on (Date) \_\_\_\_\_
- g. I, undertake that all Statutory Labour Laws including Minimum wages Act is being complied.
- h. I hereby undertake that monthly bill has been taken from the Service provider in regard to the timely and full disbursement of Salary to the outsourced staff and also that no money has been taken back/recovered from the deployed contractual staff, except the Statutory recoveries.
- i. **Log Book :**  
Service provider will maintain a separate duty slip for each ambulance, which will be signed by



the Authorised signatory of the ESIC. Before each ambulance is allotted for duty, the odometer reading shall be noted down by the driver and subsequent entries for starting time/closing time, places visited etc. for each duty during service hours. After completion of duty, the driver shall again note down the odometer reading and get it checked and signed by the ESIC Authority of ambulance deployed. On the basis of each ambulance's duty slip, the service provider shall prepare bill enclosing therewith a consolidated statements of each ambulance's running and original copies of duty slip. The log book shall also contain details of employee /requiring emergency assistance.

- j. **All inclusive Rate for Vehicle, Driver and Fuel for the base package:** Under this pricing model, the Service Provider will quote comprehensive monthly rate for the vehicle and its operation and maintenance with driver and fuel for the monthly usage variant selected. Any additional Kms will be paid separately as per quoted rates.

**10. Liquidated damages:**


Whenever and wherever it is found that the service is not up to the mark, it will be brought to the notice of the tenderer by ESIC and if no action is taken within one hour on urgent matters liquidated damages @ Rs.1000/- per complaint shall be imposed. The decision of Medical superintendent shall be final, in this regard. Further any default in terms & conditions laid under tender document will attract penalty of Rs. 1000/- for each default. The repeated default will leads to termination of contract including black listing.

**11. Manpower**

- a. Any misconduct/misbehavior on the part of the Drivers deployed by the Tenderer will not be tolerated and such person will have to be replaced by the Tenderer at his own costs, risks and responsibilities immediately, with written intimation to ESIC.
- b. The Tenderer shall ensure to maintain/retain adequate number of drivers with complying the Labour Laws and in case any Drivers absents from the duty, the reliever of equal status shall be provided by the Tenderer immediately.

**12. Risk Clause**

- a. The Contractor shall at all times have standby arrangements for carrying out the work under the Contract in case of any failure of the existing arrangement failing which penal clause will be imposed.
- b. Tenderer and its staff shall take proper and reasonable precautions to preserve from loss, destructions, waste or misuse the areas of responsibility given to them by the ESIC and shall not knowingly lend to any person or company any of the effects or assets of the ESIC under its control, any failure in this regard will attract penal clause.
- c. In the event of loss/damage of equipments etc. at the premises of the ESIC due to



negligence/carelessness of Tenderer Drivers, then the Tenderer shall compensate the loss to ESIC.


- d. The Tenderer will also maintain a suggestion book for comments on the services rendered by it.
- e. The Tenderer shall not assign or sublet this Agreement or any part thereof to any third party without the approval of the ESIC. However, he may use the services of associates for providing the services in which case the Tenderer shall be responsible for the performance and all acts of the associates as though they were his own.
- f. In every case the Contractor shall make alternative arrangements for meeting his contractual responsibilities in case of failure of the Associate.
- g. Measure of success will be based on the feedback from External Customers and staff which will be recorded and action report needs to be submitted every month by the Contractor.
- h. ESIC reserve the right for termination of the contract at any time by giving one month written notice, if the services are found unsatisfactory and also has the right to award the contract to any other selected tenderer at the cost, risk and responsibilities of Contractor and excess expenditure incurred on account of this will be recovered by ESIC from the Tenderer's Security Deposit or pending bill or by raising a separate claim.

13. **Dispute Settlement:** - It is mutually agreed that all differences and disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled by mutual discussions and negotiations if such disputes and differences cannot be settled and resolved by discussions and negotiations then the same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Medical Superintendent, ESIC Hospital, Adityapur, whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.

14. **Insolvency and breach of contract:**

The Medical Superintendent may at any time by notice in writing summarily terminate the contract without compensation to the tenderer in any of the following events that is to say:

- a. Mutual Consent: The contract may be terminated based on mutual consent in case the services are no longer required. Termination based on mutual consent will not attract any penalties or shall not be liable for any extra payments other than payment of invoices raised till the time of termination including notice period.
- b. Breach of contractual obligations: Any incidents considered as the breach of contract will result in immediate termination of services. ESIC shall have the right to terminate the contract effective immediately by giving written notice to the Service Provider, if, the service provides breaches a material provision of this contract where that breach is not capable of remedy; or if the Service Provider breaches any provision of the contract and fails to remedy the breach within 14 days after receiving notice requiring it to do so.
- c. If the tenderer being an individual or if firm, any partner in the tenderer's firm, shall at any time



be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order or orders for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceedings for liquidation or composition under any insolvency not for the time being in force or shall make any arrangement or assignment of his efforts or enter into any arrangements or composition with his creditors or suspend payment of if the firm be dissolved under partnership act, or

- d. If the tenderer being a company shall pass a resolution or the court shall make an order for the liquidation of the affairs or a receiver or manager on behalf of the debenture holder shall be appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitled the court or debenture holders to appoint a receiver or manager.
- e. If the contract commits any breach of this contract not herein specifically provided for: Provided always that such determination shall not prejudice any right of action or remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to the purchaser and provided also that the tenderer shall be liable to pay the ESIC Hospital for any extra expenditure, he is thereby put to but shall not be entitled to any gain or repurchased.




SPECIAL TENDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following special terms and conditions shall apply of Ambulance Service on Contract Basis at ESIC Hospital, Adityapur, Near Asiana More, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand -831013

1. The vehicle for ambulance should be of Type C with Basic Life support & must be **MPV Ambulance, Ambulance variant: Force Trax.**
2. The tenderer awarded with the contract shall deploy the ambulance for use of ESIC Hospital, Adityapur with valid permit and license. The tenderer shall get the vehicle registered as an ambulance by an appropriate authority.
3. The ambulance so deployed should have make year not prior to 2022 as per the Govt. Authority & the month, year of make of vehicle & Date of Purchase, should be mentioned in the tender document.
4. The ambulance so provided should be in excellent working condition ( both internally and externally ) and all times and should be cleaned thoroughly both internally and externally, boot kept clear of dust, rubbish, oil, bad odor and any personal belongings of the driver and having pollution emission level within the limit prescribed by the competent pollution control authority and conform the emission norms laid down by the Pollution control Board and the vehicle shall also poses the certificate "**Pollution Under Control**" issued from the concerned authority.
5. The Ambulances should ensure a) minimum noise of engine and body while running, b) tires with proper treads, c) appropriately inflated stepony, d) working headlights, tail lamps, indicators, speedometer milometer etc. e) proper paint on the outside f) good condition of bumpers, g) upholstery in good condition including washed and ironed white seat covers, h) proper locking or all doors i) proper closing and opening of all windows.
6. The Ambulances deployed should be arrived at designated location on time and with full or sufficient tank of fuel.
7. The Ambulances deployed shall have all the necessary permits/licenses/clearances such as, but not limited to fitness certificate, PUC, full comprehensive insurance (including third party, property and damage coverage), road permit registration certificate, as per the Motor Vehicle Act, RTO and other applicable laws and statutory bodies, for providing commercial vehicles for this service.
8. The vehicle deployed shall be free from litigation as regards ownership is concerned and shall posses no tented history as rash driving, negligence of traffic rule etc.
9. **The Vehicle shall be kept ready (with driver) 24X7 without any kind of break. In case of breakdown the agency/tenderer shall immediately arrange the suitable replacement without any extra payment.**

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10. The ambulance will necessary ply from ESIC Hospital, Adityapur to Tie-up Medical Institutions and other Government Medical Institution in and around Adityapur and Jamshedpur area.
  11. The ambulance shall be fitted with the basic amenities & equipments like stretcher, oxygen cylinder, first aid box, I.V. stand/ hanger and its shall have all the facilities/essentialities supposed to be available in the Type C with Basic Life support ambulance.
  12. The vehicle so provided shall have proper registration certificate, road tax payment certificate, fitness, insurance etc.
  13. The driver deployed shall be mentally and physically fit and shall not have any addiction towards alcoholism or smoking or drugs addiction. The Driver deployed shall have proper insurance coverage under insurance cover of accident policy for loss of life/injury etc. and compensation if any in this regard shall be borne by the tenderer.
  14. The driver deployed shall be amiable in nature and shall have not criminal records.
  15. The driver deployed shall have valid driving license and shall have at least one-year experience in running an ambulance of reputed organization.
  16. The driver deployed shall be well versed with traffic rule and shall have basic knowledge of reading and writing.
  17. The driver so deployed shall have good audible power, good eye vision and shall not be suffering from color blindness and their fitness will be got verified periodically by ESIC Hospital, Adityapur.
  18. The tenderer awarded with the contract shall maintain a log book which shall be numbered and have column as per requirement of ESIC. The log book shall be countersigned by the officer /Doctors/employee nominated by Medical Superintendent on each visit.
  19. The milo meter at the beginning and at the end of the month shall be countersigned by the tender representative and ESIC representative simultaneously.
  20. The tenderer shall manage shifting of drivers in such a manner that the 24 hours' service shall not be interrupted.
  21. The payment of wages and statutory obligations like payment of minimum wages, ESI, EPF etc. shall be observed by the tenderer strictly.
  22. The tenderer shall provide a mobile phone to the driver and the mobile phone no. shall be intimated to MS, CMO, and its shall be displayed in the noticed board.
  23. Any legal liability arising out of accident during the period of contract shall be borne by the tenderer.
  24. Any loss of property caused by the driver would be recovered from the monthly bill of the tenderer.
  25. In case of non-availability of vehicle, the ESIC Hospital would arrange its own for shifting of patient and the expenditure incurred in this way would be recovered from the monthly bill of tenderer and penal action as deemed fit will be initiate against the tenderer.
  26. The vehicle deployed shall have seats in patient cabin for an attendant as well as for one Para-medical staff.



27. The ambulance so deployed shall be pasted/printed/painted with logo, address, phone no. of ESIC Hospital, Adltyapur.
28. The Ambulance so deployed shall be fitted with blue light with siren & fire & Safety Equipments and the word "Ambulance" shall be affixed/printed on every side of the body of the vehicle in manner & standard prevailing.
29. The Bidder shall provide Ambulance on 24x7 basis .
30. The Driver deployed shall not undertake more than 8 hours shift per day and shall mandatorily be allowed weekly off.
31. In case of leave/absence of driver alternative arrangement shall be made by the agency itself.
32. In case of Breakdown or any issue whatsoever with the Ambulance alternative arrangement should be made by the agency itself.
33. Penalty will be levied, if the driver is found absent, intoxicated, misbehaving with any stake holder and / or refusing to ply; to the extent upto 10 percent of proportionate daily charges in first instance and 20 per cent in subsequent instances. Provided that if third such instance occurred agreement may be subject to termination. 6 / 9
34. It shall be mandatory to follow all applicable statutory provisions of law. The agency shall be fully responsible for all statutory liability arising out of performance of the contract and shall indemnify the ESIC with respect to any claim (including third party claims) arising out of performance of the Contract.
35. Maximum contracted distance of 1500KM per Month per Ambulance may exceed as per operational requirements of the Hospital. The agency shall also provide quote with respect to additional rate per KM to be paid if Ambulance plays more than 1500KM in a month.
36. The agency shall not pay less than minimum wages ((issued by appropriate Government under Skilled category- currently the minimum wages for Public Transport undertaking as notified by the Government of Jharkhand is Rs.712/- applicable since 01.04.2026. The minimum wages as applicable shall be mandatorily paid by the agency to the Drivers deployed) to the deployed drivers. Besides ESI/PF/Bonus and other statutory liabilities must be paid by the Agency. The payment of wages to the deployed drivers must be made by 7th of the following month.
37. The bills shall be submitted within 10 days of following month duly accompanied with log book, proof of statutory compliance along with returns of ESI/EPFO reflecting names of the deployed persons and any other document as sought by the Hospital.
38. The bidder must be registered with ESIC and EPFO.
39. Any bid which is considered financially non-viable shall be subject to outright rejection. For the purpose of deciding a bid to be financially non-viable, Monthly expenses such as Minimum wages (issued by appropriate Government under Skilled category- currently the minimum wages for Public Transport undertaking as notified by the Government of Jharkhand is Rs.712/- applicable since 01.04.2026) of driver deployed, statutory costs, fuel cost and financial cost etc. shall be considered.
40. It should have all valid licenses, permits and Insurance (including third party).



41. The Ambulance may be required to ply from Adityapur/Jamshedpur to Ranchi or any other place as per Operational Requirements.
